Mr. Klaus Heeger, General Secretary:

Low unemployment is low where vocational education works.

For this to continue to work, the recognition and appreciation of vocational education and training is crucial.

Qualification means employment in order to keep unemployment in Europe as low as possible!

It is also about values and sustainability!

Value education is indispensable - Mr. Heeger quotes a passage from the Guidelines!

Mr Heeger demands that the employed teachers and management staff also receive excellent framework conditions (school buildings, material equipment, analogue and digital assistance, fair-safe-health-promoting working conditions, so also more time for cooperative further training, regional-national-international networking, a stronger interlocking of initial and further vocational training: see Osnabrück Declaration on Vocational Education and Training in Europe and attractive performance-related salaries).
